Maldives

- 1192 coral islands- 26 natural atolls, 187 inhabited
- Population- About 520,000 (1/4th Expat.)
- Capital- Male' region >1/3rd of population
- Geography-Dispersed coral islands, small land mass
- **Economy- Dependent on tourism**
- People- Similar ethnicity, language and religion
- Politics- Young democracy





Health in Maldives

- Tiered health care system
- Tertiary hospital: Male'
- Primary care delivery
- Curative vs Preventive care
- Governance- Ministry of Health
- Universal health insurance
- Workforce & training issues





Mental Health in Maldives

- Traditional perspectives- rooted in culture
- Stigma, poor awareness & negative attitudes
- History of institutionalisation
- Arrival local health professionals
- Increasing problems of addiction
- 2004 Indian Ocean Tsunami
- Systemic efforts- Program & policy drafting
- Early efforts on prevention





Mental Health in Maldives

- NGO sector and grassroots support
- 2017- Policy endorsed and launched
- 2019- Centre for Mental health
- National Mental Health Program
- Covid19 experience- awareness & demand
- Central and Regional Mental Health Plan
- Prevention efforts- Mental health campaigns
- Formation of MH Department
- Mental health legislation drafting



Challenges

- Perceptions of Mental health- different levels, newer issues
- Governance challenges
- Intersectoral collaboration; role vs mandate
- Access to services, SMI, outer islands, treatment
- Human resource capacity
- Addiction services, detached from health sector
- Approach ; curative vs prevention: inverse pyramid
- External threats- climate change, self sustenance
- Lack of local research



Opportunities

- Increased awareness and acceptance
- Grassroots support and advocacy efforts
- Support at policy level and ensuring commitment
- Shaping mental health department with inter-sectoral input
- Robust Policies that need implementation
- Potential to shape the drafted Mental Health Legislation
- Focus and shape prevention efforts

- Opportunities to focus on research and connections







Oevaru experience


- Oevaru : historically and traditionally significant : mapping oevaru


